CADNO Schedule of Events 2019

Canadian Amputee and Disabled National Open 2019 at River's Edge Golf Club Okotoks, Alberta August 13 to 16, 2019

The 2019 Canadian Amputee and Disabled National Open (CADNO) will be held in Okotoks, Alberta at the River's Edge Golf Club. The event will be a 54 hole tournament open to all amputees and people with qualifying disabilities.

River's Edge is a unique 18 hole golf experience with 2 different 9 hole layouts. The original South 9 was opened in 1994 and runs down into the valley situated along the Sheep river, it features holes with narrow fairways lined with 50 foot tall Poplars. The North 9 opened for play in 2004 and features water on 4 holes with their signature hole number 9 an island green. The course has hosted the Alberta Amputee Provincial Tournament a number of times and is an amputee friendly course. The course has also hosted the Alberta Ladies Amateur Championship. The Town of Okotoks is located approximately 20 kms south of Calgary and has a population of 29,000. It offers some unique shops and dining in Old Town Okotoks. Being so close to Calgary you can visit the Calgary Zoo home of the Panda's from China or visit Studio Bell, Home of the National Music Centre. The Banff National Park and Canadian Rockies are an hour and a half away.

The Town of Okotoks is a 45 min drive south from Calgary International Airport (YYC) depending on traffic and the time of day you arrive.

The host hotel is the Best Western Plus Okotoks Inn & Suites at 100 Southbank Road, Okotoks, Alberta, T1S 0N3. The hotel is a 5 min drive to the course. The hotel offers a full hot breakfast to guests. A block of rooms has been reserved at a rate of \$149.50 + tax until **July 12th, 2019**. Book your room early to ensure availability. Tournament Information:

Players wishing to compete for the Championship Title will be playing from the Blue tees at approximately 6300 yards.

Senior and Super Senior players and players with a handicap under 25 have the option of playing from the White tee's 5900 yards.

Super Super Senior players and players with a handicap over 25 have the option of playing from the Red tee's 5300 yards.

Ladies will play from the Red tee's 5300 yards.

Divisions and Awards will be determined after all entries have been received and are subject to change depending on the number of entries and type of disabilities entered.

Please let me know if you're planning on playing a practise round so I may have enough tee's blocked off for the event.

We will have an Associates Division to allow spouses and partners to play as well. They would be playing at the end of the tournament tee times.

Unfortunately the course does not have the ability to store clubs as it has limited storage.

More detailed information will be sent out as we get closer to the event.
